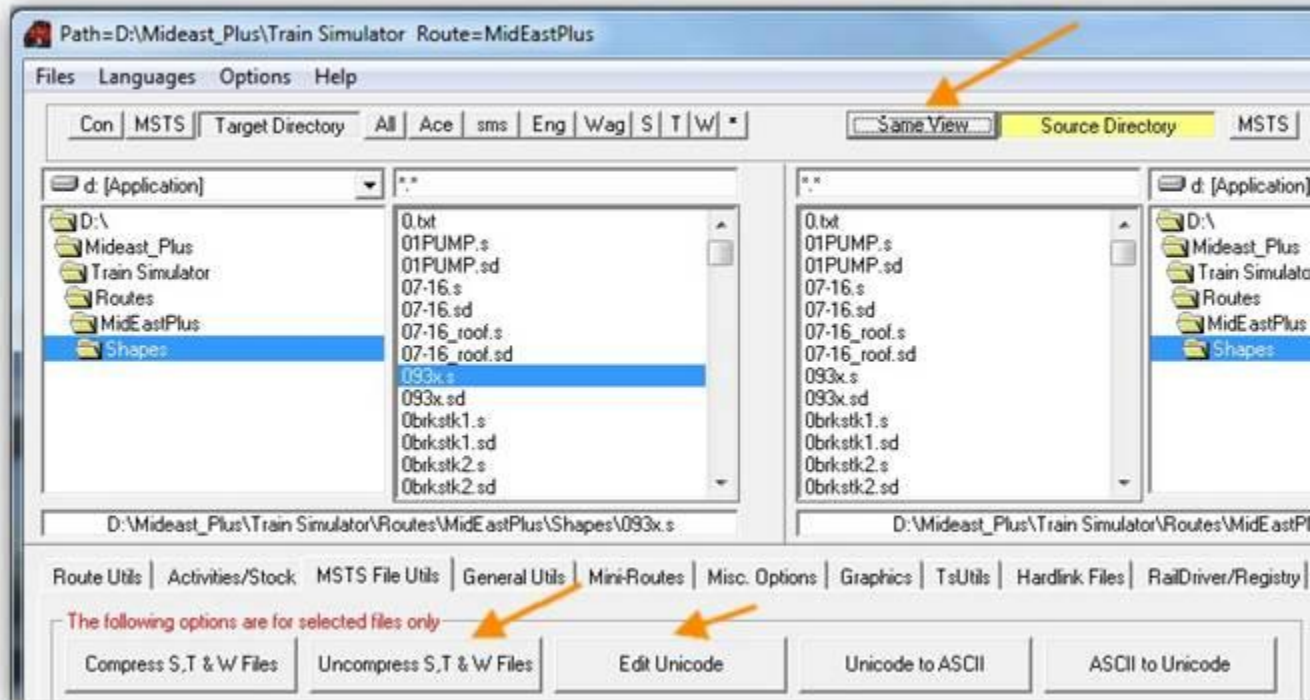


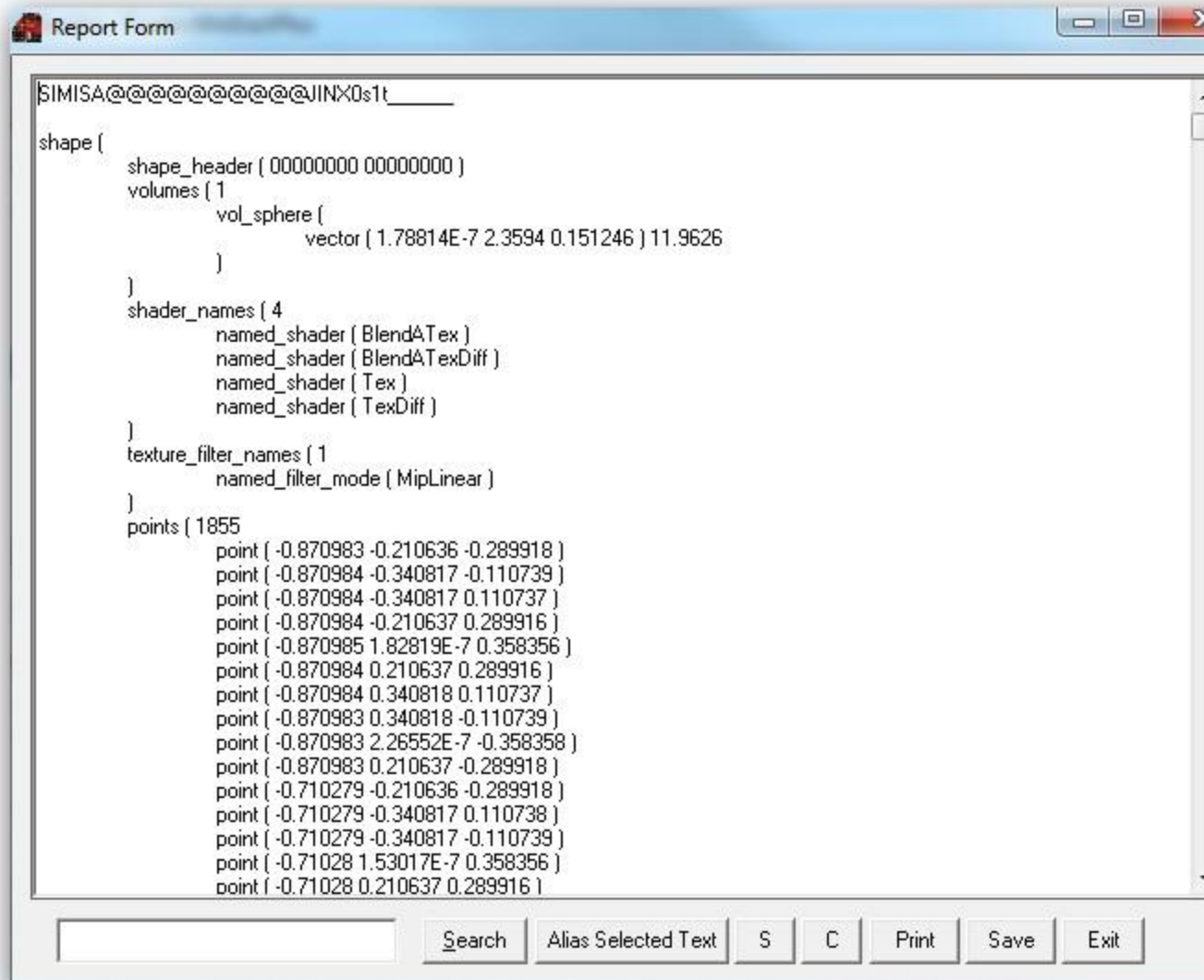
How you uncompress .s files depends upon whether you wish to uncompress the .s file in situ or whether you wish to uncompress it to a temporary folder, leaving the original one untouched.

If you wish to uncompress the .s file in situ,

1. Go to the MSTS File Utils tab
2. Select your .s file in the left hand file window
3. Click the 'Same View' button as shown below so that both boxes contain the same files, i.e. the destination is the same as the source.



4. Now click the Uncompress S, T & W files button, you will be told you need to select the destination, but you have already done that
5. Select the .s file again and Click the Edit Unicode button and you will see the uncompressed version in the editor window as under



6. You can edit the file here and click Save to re-save it.
7. If you wish to uncompress the .s file to a temporary folder, just navigate to somewhere like c:\temp in the right hand window.
